




Significance Continued:

Richard Harrison Earle, a farmer and landowner, was the grandson of Col. Elias Earle, a founder of Greenville. The house with few alterations is one of the few mid-nineteenth century Greek Revival buildings left within the Greenville city limits. It is surrounded by one of the largest areas of woodland remaining in the city.
